- a) Sustainable energy management (4 h):
 - Energy policy of EU and Poland, energy balance of Poland
 - Renewable energy in Poland in view of other EOG countries
 - Good practice in energy management in EOG countries
 - Energy management in sustainable development of communes
 - Open paper session (NGOs, students' scientific associations, etc. – sent papers)
- b) Sustainable waste management (4 h)
 - EU waste management policy and national programs, wastes balance in Poland
 - Waste management in Poland in view of other EOG countries
 - Good practice in waste management in EOG countries
 - Biowastes in everyday life (collection, treatment)
 - Open paper session (NGOs, students' scientific associations, etc. – sent papers)

The Conference is to start at 9 a.m. and close at 5 p.m.

THE SUBJECT OF WORKSHOPS - 25.04.2008

Practical workshops (field workshops) in working groups of approx. 20 participants.

- Energy management on a local scale – potential vs. practice;
- Energy conservation and utilization of renewable energy in practice;
- Reduction of packaging waste levels – potential vs. practice, sustainable consumption;
- Biowastes and biodegradable packaging – available technologies, guidelines;

In the afternoon joint recapitulation of workshops (2 h) between working groups, exchange of experiences and the creation of programs for educational activities in individual subject groups.

Workshops are to start at 9 a.m. and close at 4 p.m.

Participants will receive certificates of participation in the Conference and Workshops.
